Confidentiality is a key concern for us, and any information about counselling clients will only be shared with their consent, unless there is a serious risk to their, or someone else's, safety.

The information provided to us is kept in a separate system that is operated on behalf of Heriot Watt by PCMIS. PCMIS system processes, security and infrastructure are approved by the NHS Digital and the Information Governance Toolkit (IG Toolkit). The data is held securely by PCMIS but is owned by Heriot Watt University.
